**Directions to King's House:****From the Twin Cities Metro Area**

State Highway 55 West to Buffalo. Left at Settlers Parkway (landmark: Target) until roundabout onto 25 North to three way stop. Left onto Montrose Blvd/Cty Rd 12. to 7th Street; go right down to the "T". Turn right and find our parking lot.

**From Downtown Buffalo**

State Hwy 25 South to Montrose Blvd./County Road 12. At 25 South & Montrose Blvd, Right onto Montrose Blvd/Cty Rd 12. Go South to 7th Street. Right on 7th Street into the Retreat Center.

**From State Highway 12**

From State Hwy 12 between Delano and Montrose, go North on State Hwy 25 (approx 7 mi) to 13th Street (Zion Lutheran Church on the right) Left on 13th Street to 2nd Ave; right on 2nd Ave. to Montrose Blvd. Right to 7th Street. Left to Christ the King Retreat Center. Right at the "T" into parking lot.

**Shuttle Service from Minneapolis-St. Paul Airport**
